There are three *customized* reports that can be printed on demand by the RELY FOR TEMPS TEST software. All three reports are based on how the individual answered questions on the RELY FOR TEMPS TEST. The reports are:

RESULTS AND INTERPRETATION REPORT

This report explains what the applicant's answers mean with respect to his or her attitudes toward work ethic issues, including a description of the individual's probable on-the-job behavior.

ADMISSIONS REPORT

This report provides specific feedback for the interviewer about what this applicant said in response to questions that ask about previous work ethic-related behavior by the applicant. The report includes suggestions about how to ask an applicant about answers on specific questions in a way that is respectful and informative.

INTERVIEW GUIDE

This report provides assistance to the interviewer in using the RELY FOR TEMPS TEST results during an interview with an applicant. Specific questions may be included in this report, as determined by the way an applicant responded to the RELY FOR TEMPS TEST.

How Can The RELY FOR TEMPS TEST Reports Be Included In The Hiring Process?
