This is a test of general knowledge. It asks a series of questions, and poses a number of problems, that require you to use your common sense. Here is a sample question:

Sample Question 1: If “out” is the opposite of “in”, then what is the opposite of “up”? (Write the number of the correct choice as the answer to this question in the space provided.)

1. back 2. right 3. down 4. forth 5. left [3]

The correct answer is “3”.

Sample question #2 is a different kind of question:

Sample Question 2: Look at the mathematical statement, “ $2+2=4$ ”. Is this statement:

1. always true 2. usually true 3. could be either true or false 4. usually false 5. always false [1]

The correct answer is “1”, because $2+2=4$ is always 4.

This test contains 50 questions. **You will have 12 minutes to work on the test.** Do not be concerned if you do not complete all 50 questions; few people do. The best way to take this test is to work quickly, but not so quickly that you make unnecessary mistakes. The questions get harder as you go, so skipping a question means that the next question will be harder than the one you skipped. Make sure you understand the instructions. The person who is administering the test will not answer any questions once the test begins.

You may not use a calculator or any calculating device to help you answer these questions, but you may use the margins of the test to compute answers if you wish.

Put down your pencil and wait to be told to begin.
